


# What you need

  - Why not draw some of your ideas on paper first.
  - Start testing out different ways to fold or roll your news paper pages. How can you make the longest and strongest shape possible?
- Make your tower. Why not compete against your family members!
- Test your tower out to see if it can stand on its own. How tall did you manage to make it? Use the Maker{Cycle} to keep improving your ideas.



### {Top tip}

Rolling newspaper into tubes is a good way to make it stronger. Try rolling it diagonally from one corner.
