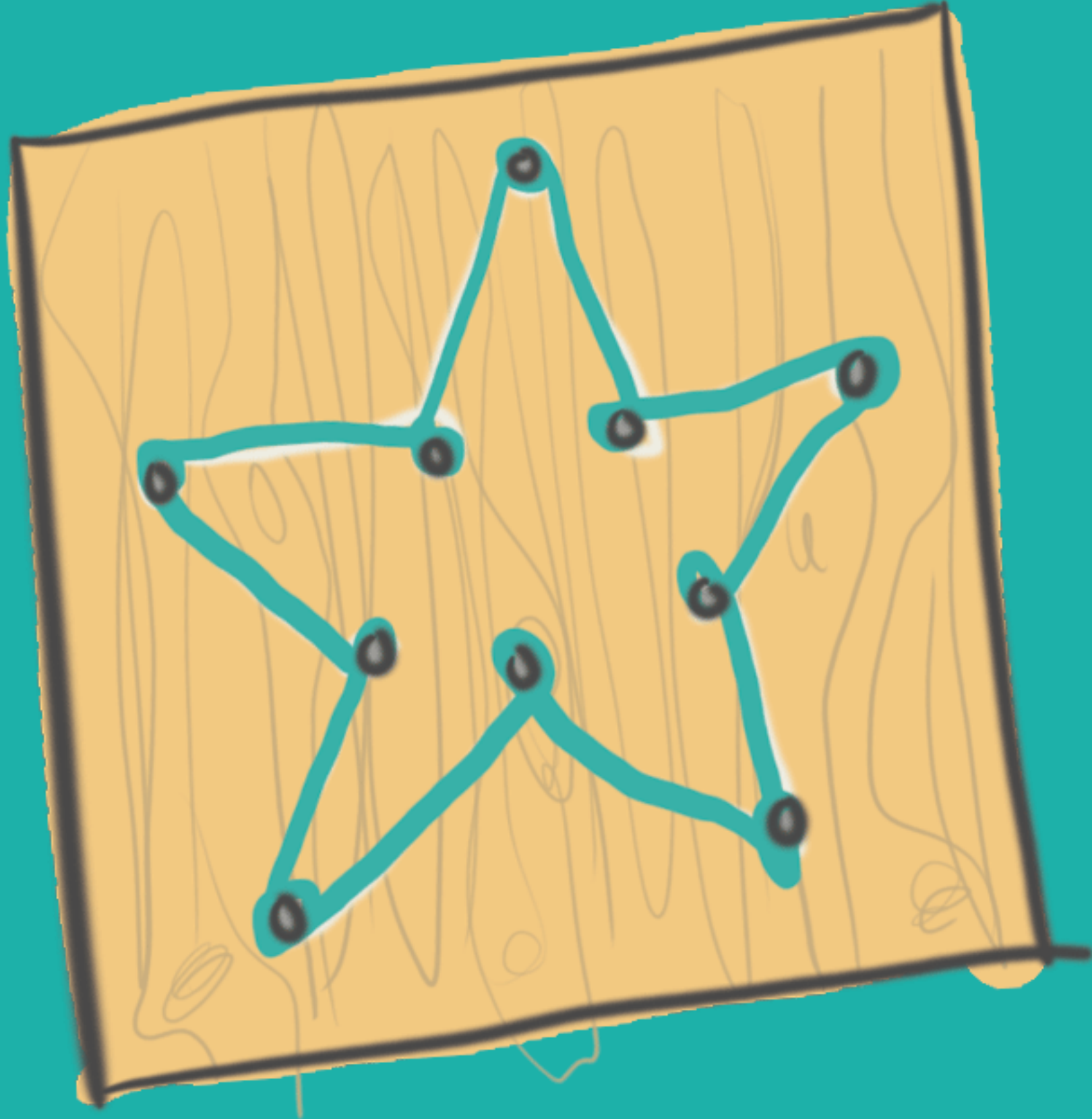

# Pin and String Challenge



# What you need:

- **Pins**
  - **Hammer**
  - **Piece of wood**
  - **String**
  - **Pencil**

# Pin and String Art

## {Challenge}

Get hands on with a hammer and pins to make your own pin and string art!

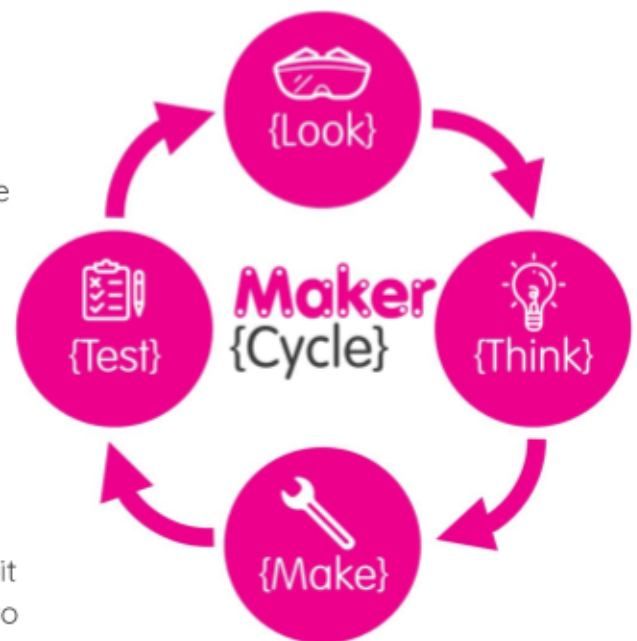


## What you need

- Pins
- Hammer
- Piece of wood
- String
- Pencil

## Use the Maker{Cycle} to create like a Maker:

- Get an adult to help you with this challenge, together **look** carefully at the materials.
- **Think** about what you want your pin and string art to be of. Sketch your design on the wood with a pencil. (Straight lines will be easier than curved shapes)
- Mark the corners of your shape with your pencil. This is where the nails will go.
- Now carefully start nailing the pins into the wood following the outline of your sketch.
- Hold the pin in your fingers and tap lightly with the hammer, once the pin is secure, remove your fingers and now hit the pin a bit harder. Don't hammer the pin all the way into the wood, keep it around 1 cm long.
- Once you have placed all your pins, **make** your art by connecting the string. Wrap the string around the first peg a few times and then tie a knot to secure. Now loop your string around the rest of the pins to create your art work!



## {Top tip}

Why not try painting your string to give your art more colour?
